
### **Medicaid** (Data ending 5/31/2024; Updated: 6/2024)



Due to implementation of the new Ohio Medicaid Enterprise System and changes to the Data Warehouse, there will be delay in updating Medicaid Payments data until further notice.











### **Publicly Funded Child Care**


Child Care is vital to many Hamilton County families; allowing parents to maintain employment or schooling while receiving quality child care for their children.




