

Food & Cash Assistance (Data ending 9/30/2024; Updated: 10/2024)







Medicaid (Data ending 8/31/2024; Updated: 10/2024)












Medicaid-Funded Transportation for Medical Appointments (9/1/2023 - 8/31/2024 Data updated quarterly after billing)


Publicly Funded Child Care


Child Care is vital to many Hamilton County families; allowing parents to maintain employment or schooling while receiving quality child care for their children.


